

# MYRINGOTOMY WITH TUBE INSERTION DISCHARGE INSTRUCTIONS

### DIET

• Resume previous diet

#### **ACTIVITY**

No restrictions

#### **MEDICATIONS**

•	Ear drops	times per day, for	_davs.
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- Discomfort or fever is usually relieved by Tylenol or Motrin.
- Do not take aspirin, see Pain Control Sheet for additional instructions.
- If oral antibiotics were prescribed, please take all the medication.

#### **FOLLOW-UP**

• If arrangements for follow-up have not been made before you leave the surgery center today, please call the office you are usually seen in to make those arrangements.

## WORK/SCHOOL

• You may return the day after surgery.

#### INFORMATION

- Bloody drainage from the ear is normal and will reduce over the first 3 days.
- Report drainage from the ear that persists longer than 5 days.
- Notify the doctor for fever if it persists above 102.5 during the first 24 hours of surgery.
- Swimming and bathing are allowed while the tubes are in. NO EARPLUGS ARE NEEDED.
- Should you have increased drainage and irritation related to prolong water exposure, use the antibiotic drops given to you after surgery. If this does not relieve the problem in 3 days, call our office.
